MATERIALS

CCX656 Flared Mug Medium Brush Detail Brush Liner Brush Fan Brush Water-Based Marker Ballpoint Pen NCR Mushroom Pattern

COLORS

CMM 15 - Mississippi Mud CMM 45 - Indigo CMM 59 - Turquoise CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 5 - Coral Reef CMM - 67 Snowflake CMM 82 - Olive You CMM 12 - Mocha Java CMM 31 - Licorice

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Thin down Turquoise paint with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 2. Use a fan brush to apply 2 coats of the watered-down Turquoise to the outside of the mug.
- 3. Use a medium brush to apply 3 coats of Indigo to the handle.
- 4. When the outside of the mug is dry, apply the pattern to the mug by pressing firmly as you trace over the lines in the pattern.
- 5. Thin down the following colors with 30% water to 70% paint: Banana Boat, Coral Reef, Indigo, Olive, Mississippi Mud, Snowflake, and Mocha Java.
- 6. Use a detail or liner brush to fill in the stems with 1 heavy layers of watered-down paint. We used Mocha Java and Mississippi Mud.
- 7. Next, use a detail or liner brush to fill in the caps with 1 heavy layers of watered-down paint. We used Banana Boat, Indigo, Coral Reef, and Olive You.
- 8. Use a fan brush to apply 3 coats of Banana Boat to the inside of the mug.
- 9. Fill in the underside of the mushroom caps with 1-2 coats of watered-down Snowflake.
- 10.Use a water-based marker to sketch out the writing. Then, use a detail brush and Licorice paint to apply 1 coat to the writing.

TIPS

• To apply the watered-down paint to the mushrooms, instead of brushing the paint on, load up the detail or liner brush and drop a ball of paint onto the piece. Then, gently move it around to create a heavy layer. Load up the brush as needed until the section is filled in.
